



## **I-190/Silver Street Construction Project**

RAPID CITY, S.D. – The South Dakota Department of Transportation says the northbound ramp to Interstate 190 at the intersection of West Boulevard / Anamosa Street in Rapid City will close permanently on Monday, March 7.

Also on March 7, the contractor will begin the process of closing the southbound lanes of I-190 and placing two-way traffic in the northbound lanes.

Work on the southbound lanes includes total reconstruction of the roadway and construction of a new bridge. This is the second phase of a two-year project to reconstruct the interchange and about one mile of I-190.

Motorists are asked to slow down through the work zone and be prepared for suddenly slowing, merging and stopped traffic, as well as construction workers and equipment adjacent to the roadway.

The overall completion date of this project is Oct. 27, 2017.

Reede Construction of Aberdeen is the prime contractor on this \$34 million project.
